COVID-19 ADVICE FOR PASSENGERS

Tasmania's own Redline is responding to COVID-19 under the guidance of the Tasmanian Government (Department of Health), the health and safety of passengers and staff is our highest priority.

We have enhanced sanitisation of all buses and will continue to ensure vehicles remain as clean as possible.

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19 while travelling please consider the following guidelines:

- Plan ahead and **travelling outside peak** times where possible, to reduce the possibility of person-to-person virus transmission
- **Apply social distancing** principles, as best as possible, on all our coach services and in our transit centres
- **Cover your nose and mouth** when you cough or sneeze, or sneeze into the crook of your elbow
- **Avoid cash handling** where possible by purchasing commuter tickets online at: <http://www.tasredline.com.au/> or by buying bulk school tickets from the driver using correct change to minimise transactions.
- practising good hygiene after coming in contact with handles, rails, buttons and windows during your journey. **Clean your hands with soap and water or hand sanitiser** afterwards.
